# Speakers



## Jonathan Lamb

Jonathan worked as a teacher before joining the staff of UCCF and then Belmont Chapel, Exeter. In 1989 he became the IFES Regional Secretary for Europe and the former Soviet Union, overseeing a team of staff working across 50 countries, and in 2000 was appointed as the IFES Associate General Secretary.

He presently serves as Director of Langham Preaching, a programme that seeks to provide practical support for a new generation of preachers and teachers around the world. He has also served as chairman of Word Alive and is now the chairman of the Keswick Convention.

He and his wife, Margaret, live in Oxford, and they have three daughters. He enjoys music of all kinds, photography, reading, travel, sailing, and Chinese food!



## Paul David Tripp

Paul is the president of Paul Tripp Ministries, a nonprofit organization, whose mission statement is “Connecting the transforming power of Jesus Christ to everyday life.” This leads Paul to weekly speaking engagements around the world. In addition to this, Paul is Professor of Pastoral Life and Care at Redeemer Seminary in Dallas, Texas; the Executive Director of the Center for Pastoral Life and Care in Fort Worth, Texas, and has taught at respected institutions worldwide. As an author, Paul has written eleven books on Christian living that are read and distributed internationally.

He has been married for many years to Luella and they have four grown up children.



## Rebecca Manley-Pippert

Rebecca Pippert is founder of Salt Shaker Ministries: a teaching/training ministry in evangelism. Having ministered extensively around the world, Becky has a global perspective on being a sensitive and effective witness for Christ. The International Fellowship of Evangelical Students recently named Becky their Senior Trainer in Evangelism and Seeker Studies for Europe.

Becky is the author of nine books that include the modern classic, *Out of the Salt Shaker*, which was named recently by Christianity Today as one of the books that has most influenced Christian thought in the past 50 years.

She is married with 4 young adult aged children and she and her husband live in Louisville, Kentucky.



## Richard Pratt

Richard is the President of Third Millennium Ministries ([www.thirdmill.org](http://www.thirdmill.org)) which exists to provide “Biblical education, for the world, for free.” It particularly focuses on helping Christian leaders where the church is growing the fastest but where there is the least training available. Currently they provide a multimedia seminary curriculum in English, Arabic, Chinese (Mandarin), Russian and Spanish.

Richard chaired the Old Testament Department and taught at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson MS and Orlando FL for 21 years. He has traveled extensively throughout the world to evangelise and lecture, including Australia, China, Eastern Europe, Central America and Russia.



## John Wyatt

John is Emeritus Professor of Neonatal Paediatrics at University College London. He was engaged in clinical practice as a paediatrician and academic researcher into the prevention of brain injury in newborn babies for more than 25 years. He is now active in research and teaching on ethical and philosophical issues raised by advances in medical technology. He is chairman of the Christian Medical Fellowship Study Group and a Board Member of Biocentre and of the London Institute for Contemporary Christianity. He is a member of All Souls Church, London. His book, *Matters of Life and Death*, is published by InterVarsity Press.



## William Taylor

William grew up on a farm in Cornwall and served in the British Army as an officer in the Royal Green Jackets for five years before being ordained. In 1995 he joined St Helen's Church, Bishopsgate, in the heart of the City of London, and became Rector in 1998. The ministry at St Helen's has for many years had a focus on reaching the business community; there are also vibrant Sunday congregations reaching, amongst others, students, young workers, families and internationals.

William is married to Janet and they have three teenage children – Emily, Digby and Archie.



## Stuart Townend

Stuart is known and respected around the world as one of the leading worship songwriters of his generation. The depth of lyrical and theological content in songs such as *In Christ alone* and *How deep the Father's love* have caused some to draw comparisons with the greats of previous generations such as Watts and Wesley, while the marriage of great lyrics with wonderfully accessible melodies (largely through his partnership with Keith Getty) means his songs bridge different musical and cultural genres, and reach into every corner of the globe.

The accommodation for both DBB and self-catering is in ground or first-floor apartments which have one or two bedrooms as well as a sofa bed in a lounge/kitchen area. For the New Word Alive event the prices quoted include electricity, heating, bed linen and pillows for all standards of accommodation.

## Dinner, Bed & Breakfast (DBB)

If you fancy a holiday without the cooking and washing up then DBB is for you. You can wake up to a full English or Continental breakfast, and also enjoy a delicious choice of evening meals. All this for the equivalent of only £8/day for each person! Pontins can usually cater for special dietary requirements, please ask for more details when you make your booking.

The accommodation for self-catering and DBB comes in three grades:

### Budget

Offering fantastic value for money, Pontin's Budget apartments come with a fully fitted kitchen, bathroom, colour TV, and a lounge area with double bed settee.

### Classic

Classic apartments have all the facilities of Budget, but include a shower. They are located just a short walk from the main conference venues and children's activities, so your kids will love their convenience.

### Club

Located in the pleasant surroundings of landscaped areas, Pontin's Club apartments will make you feel that extra bit special. Enjoy free towels, a colour TV with digital channels and a complimentary bathroom pack of goodies. There is also a microwave and toaster provided.

## Discount for Students

### Places available from £105!

A limited number of units have been discounted and reserved for students. Budget self-catering apartments sleeping 4 people are available at £420 or £105 each for 4 people. Classic apartments sleeping 4 people are available for £460 or £115 each for 4 people. You can only book per apartment. When you book you must provide your UCCF student card number. If you haven't got a UCCF student card you can get one easily and quickly at the UCCF website [www.uccf.org.uk](http://www.uccf.org.uk).

## Low-Income Discounted Places

There are some discounted units for families where the main income provider receives either Income Support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, or has a valid NHS tax credit exemption certificate (however these are not intended for church ministers). Subject to availability you can choose between:

- Budget Self-Catering Apartment sleeping 6 for £390
- Budget Dinner, Bed & Breakfast sleeping 5 for £449

Please note that places are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please do not book directly with Pontins but follow the instructions on the application form. After 30th September 2011 any remaining low income units will be released for general sale.

## Day Visitors & Event Passes

You may prefer to stay in a B&B, caravan or cottage local to Prestatyn and come to New Word Alive each day. To do so you will need to buy an Event Pass giving you access to the full New Word Alive programme as well as the facilities of the Holiday Park. Event Passes will be available in the autumn. # Holiday Information

## All you need to bring

Self-Catering & Dinner, Bed & Breakfast Apartments: bed linen and cooking items, crockery and cutlery are all provided. Bring washing up items, towels, toiletries and personal effects. In Club apartments towels are provided.

## Dinner, Bed & Breakfast meals

Breakfast and an evening meal are provided including dinner on the day of arrival and breakfast on the day of departure. All meals offer vegetarian options and Pontins always try and meet other dietary requirements when informed in advance.

## Disabled Guests

Pontins are happy to provide as much advice and information as possible to people with special needs. There are a limited number of accommodation units that have been modified for wheelchair users. Please discuss any special requirements at the time of booking so that the most suitable accommodation can be arranged. Pontins will do their best to meet your requirements but advise that they cannot always be guaranteed.

## Infants

Cots and high chairs are available for hire at a charge of £10 each. Generally in the accommodation cots will need to be located in the living area. Please note that you will have to bring your own cot linen. High chairs are available free of charge in the restaurant. In addition note that the accommodation number refers to the total number of people allowed in a unit regardless of age.

## Children

Except when registered in the appropriate New Word Alive programme sessions, children may not be left alone without full adult supervision. Whilst every care is taken, children remain the responsibility of their parents or guardians at all times. At least one adult (over 18) must occupy each unit of accommodation. Children should not be left unattended in their accommodation.

# Terms and Conditions

## 1) Data protection

Pontins is a trading name of Britannia Jinky Jersey Limited. New Word Alive is the trading name for Christian Events, of which Britannia Jinky Jersey Limited are acting as agent. Britannia Jinky Jersey Limited and Christian Events are notified (registered) as data controllers under the Data Protection Act 1998. Britannia Jinky Jersey Limited will use the personal information that you provide to process your booking and provide your holiday. They will also use the details you provide for related purposes including marketing, and providing selected organisation with your details so they can provide you with information about services and products which may interest you. They will also pass your information to New Word Alive. You must inform other members in your party of the information about them that you are providing and what we will use it for. You can withdraw your consent for the above at any time by writing to the Direct Marketing Department at the first address shown in (3).

Christian Events (New Word Alive) will use the personal information you provide to plan and evaluate their programme and to keep you informed about the event you are attending. They will not share your information with any other parties, but may occasionally contact you with details of other New Word Alive events, products or initiatives and/or information from their carefully selected partners. If you do not wish to receive such information, please write to the Customer Service Manager, New Word Alive, Willcox House, 160-168 Borough High Street, London, SE1 1LB.

## 2) Your Booking and Reservation

All bookings for New Word Alive must be made by telephone or internet. The deposit of £100 per unit must be paid at the time of booking by credit or debit card. When you receive your confirmation of booking if any details are incorrect please contact Pontins on 0844 576 5949 or 01745 881800. Payment of the balance must be made by the 11th January 2012 and can be made by either credit/debit card or cheque.

## 3) The Holiday Contract

A contract between you and New Word Alive with Pontins is made when your booking and deposit payment are accepted by Pontins.

The contract is between Britannia Jinky Jersey Limited trading as Pontins, trading office Ainsdale House, Shore Road, Ainsdale, Southport, PR8 2PZ and registered office 15 Esplanade, St Helier, Jersey, JE1 1RB and you (the lead name provided when booking). The contract binds you and all the members of your party. It is your responsibility to ensure that all members of your party accept these terms and conditions of booking. Failure to disclose all relevant information or comply with these terms may lead to termination of the contract, and loss of the booking.

## 4) If you change your booking

Should you wish to make a change after your booking is confirmed, such as the type of accommodation, please ring Pontins immediately. They will always try to meet your request. However, they reserve the right to charge £10 per alteration.

## 5) If you cancel your booking

Should you wish to cancel your holiday please contact Pontins immediately and they will advise you of the procedure. Cancellation will not take effect until they receive written confirmation sent by recorded delivery or email. If this is not received before your holiday is due to start no refund will be given.

## 6) If we make any major alterations to your booking

It may be necessary to make alterations in advance of your holiday in which case Pontins and New Word Alive will endeavour to advise you as soon as possible. You will have the following options if we make a major change to your booking:

- Accept the alternative arrangement as notified to you
- Full refund of any money you have paid

## 7) Minor alterations

Alterations such as the withdrawal of certain amenities, facilities, activities and entertainment may be made by Pontins or New Word Alive for reasons beyond our control or due to operational circumstances without any obligation or liability.

## 8) Limitation of Liability

Pontins accepts responsibility for those arrangements of your holiday that are within their control but they cannot accept liability for any injury, loss or damage suffered by you or any other member of your party, unless one of the following applies.

- There was wilful default by Pontins, their employees or agents.
- Death or personal injury was caused by the negligence of Pontins, their employees or agents.

For all claims other than death or personal injury, which result from the non-performance or improper performance of their contract, we will pay compensation that is reasonable in all circumstances.

## 9) Pricing

We guarantee the price shown and agreed on your invoice for your accommodation is the amount payable by you. All accommodation is charged per unit.

## 10) We need to know

Your name and address. The names and ages of all members of your party (this is a legal requirement for Pontins). Whether any of your party has restricted mobility or access requirements.

## 11) Health and safety

For the safety and well being of our guests, not all facilities are available to everyone and certain height and/or age restrictions apply. Proof of age may be asked for when buying alcohol on the Park.

## 12) If you have a comment

If you are dissatisfied with any aspect of your break, in the first instance, please speak to the Reception Staff or Duty Manager at the Park. If at the end of your holiday you feel that we have not dealt with your complaint satisfactorily please write to Guest Relations at the first address in (3) above, no later than 28 days after the end of the event.

## 13) Care of facilities

Please treat your holiday property and park facilities with care so that others may continue to enjoy them. We ask that you report any accidental damage to Reception immediately so that we can make a repair or replacement. Accommodation is inspected at the end of every stay and you may be charged for any loss or damage.

## 14) Unacceptable behaviour

We reserve the right to terminate a holiday without compensation where unreasonable or anti-social behaviour, caused by those persons named on their booking, or their guests, impairs the enjoyment, comfort or health of other guests.

## 15) Infectious or contagious diseases

Guests must inform the Pontins and New Word Alive of any such illnesses which occurs up to 4 weeks prior to the event or during the event itself that may affect other guests. For the protection of guests and employees, anyone found to have such a condition may have their booking cancelled, be confined on the Holiday Park or will be requested to leave.

## 16) Filming and photography

Please be aware that filming and photography may take place during your holiday and take note of the positions of cameras at all times. We will not accept responsibility if contrary to your wishes you appear on film or in photographs.

## 17) Pets

With the exception of assistance dogs notified to us on booking, pets are not allowed on the Park.

## 18) Brochure accuracy

Every care is taken to ensure that all brochure information is accurate at the time of going to press. Photographs and artist's impressions are illustrative only.

## Make your choice

Decide the type of accommodation you wish to book. Accommodation is sold on a first come first served basis and some types sell out quickly so it might be worth having a second choice in mind.

When you book you will be asked for the following:

- A lead name (who must be over 18) and postal address for correspondence.
- The names and ages of the others attending.
- A deposit of £100 by credit/debit card for each unit booked. This payment must be made by the lead person who will also need to make all subsequent payments.

**Group Organisers:** If you would like to book multiple units for a group you can pre-register with Pontins who will then call you on 30th June to take your booking.
